Duties:

Student will work in the greenhouse, field, and seed lab of the Tomato Genetics Resource Center (TGRC). The TGRC is a genebank of tomato mutants, related wild species, and other types of genetic stocks. Activities in the greenhouse and field include transplanting, pollinating, fruit harvesting, seed processing, taking notes and general plant care. Duties also include preparing seed samples for distribution and entering data using Microsoft Access and Excel. Requirements:

Students should have prior experience and/or an interest in working with plants. Some coursework in biology, horticulture, and genetics is helpful. Other requirements include the ability to record data carefully and reliably, conscientious and responsible work habits, and good team work.
